PURPOSE OF AWARD:

Recognition of distinguished service to the Ladies' Auxiliary of the Maryland State Firemen's Association.

AWARD SPONSOR:

Ladies Auxiliary of the Maryland State Firemen's Association.

AWARD ADMINISTERED BY:

Ladies Auxiliary of the Maryland State Firemen's Association Hall of Fame Committee.

BACKGROUND:

The Hall of Fame Award was established in 2001 by President Nora Ryan to recognize the distinguished service of individuals of the Ladies' Auxiliary of the Maryland State Firemen's Association.

AWARD RULES:

1. The Committee will be authorized to select five (5) inductees each year. The inductee can be either living or deceased. Upon completion of the President's term of office she/he shall automatically be placed in the Hall of Fame.
2. Names of individuals for nomination may be submitted by the nominee's home Auxiliary, any individual in good standing in any Auxiliary, or an individual member(s) of the Hall of Fame Committee.
3. Nominees must have a minimum of ten (10) years of service to the L.A. M.S.F.A.

4. Nominations will be limited to members of Auxiliaries who are members of the L.A. M.S.F.A.
5. Nomination shall be based upon distinguished service to the L.A. M.S.F.A. Service to the nominee's local and/or County Auxiliary may be considered as supporting service but award will be based upon service to the L.A. M.S.F.A. first.

6. All nominations must be in letter form addressed to the Chairperson of the Hall of Fame Committee. All nominations must be in the hands of the Chairperson on or before May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Nomination letters will not be carried over from year to year. Until selected, a letter of nomination must be submitted each year.
7. Selection of nominees to the L.A. M.S.F.A. Hall of Fame will be made annually by the members of the Hall of Fame Committee.
8. All individuals selected to the L.A. M.S.F.A. Hall of Fame will receive two (2) certificates (one for the individual and one for her/his Auxiliary), a pocket card and a lapel pin.
9. The names of the individuals selected to the Hall of Fame and the rules of the Hall of Fame Award shall be published in the annual proceedings book of the L.A. M.S.F.A. along with the year the selection was made.
10. The names of the individuals selected to the Hall of Fame shall be engraved on a master plaque that is displayed in the Maryland Firefighters room which is located at the University of Maryland in College Park, MD.
11. A picture of the nominee should be included with the nomination letter.
