

HONEY AWARD

Entries must be submitted to the current President of the Ladies’ Auxiliary of the Maryland State Firemen’s Association by a date determined by the President. The officers of the LAMSFA will review all entries and select a winner.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Individual must be a member of a member auxiliary of the Ladies’ Auxiliary of the Maryland State Firemen’s Association.
2. Individual must have been a member of their home auxiliary for more than twenty (20) years.
3. Individual must have served in their county auxiliary organization.
4. Individual must have served with the Ladies’ Auxiliary of the Maryland State Firemen’s Association.
5. Individual must have served their community in some capacity in addition to their auxiliary; such as church, youth organization, or school organization.
