A Special Meeting of the Executive Committee was called to order by President Roger A. Steger, Sr., at 1400 hours for the purpose of a report from Attorney Roger Powell on a recent 4th District Court Ruling.

Attorney Powell reported on a recent ruling he had just learned of from the 4th District Court and possible affects on the volunteer fire, rescue, and emergency medical services of Maryland. This ruling stemmed from an original case involving the Chestnut Ridge Volunteer Fire Company in Baltimore County. He also reported that he must submit papers to the court as a result of this ruling. After some discussion the following motion was made by L. Sachs and seconded by W. Donaldson:

Motion: That the Executive Committee authorize the President to take the necessary actions with the filing of En Banc Hearing papers with the 4th District Court. Motion unanimously passed.

There being no further business to come before the Executive Committee the meeting was adjourned at 1430 hours.
